OVERVIEW

This programme proposes a way of experiencing the territory through time and attention.

WWG structures the experience not as a sequence of activities, but as a rhythm — between lightly guided moments and autonomous exploration, where the place reveals itself gradually.

In the Lima Valley, the experience shifts from observation to presence. The territory is not something to be covered — it is inhabited.


Between landscape, vine, river and community, a continuous relationship takes shape, where time no longer structures the experience from the outside, but becomes part of it



PROGRAMME STRUCTURE

DAY 0 — ARRIVAL

- Check-in at the accommodation
- Free time to settle into the place
- Dinner at leisure

 A gradual entry into the rhythm of the territory

DAY 1 — SISTELO & LIMA VALLEY

→ Sistelo — Cultural Landscape


- Village of Sistelo
- WWG interpretative walk
- Understanding the relationship between terraces, human work and landscape
- Simple tasting of local products

→ Lima Valley — Vine and River

- Cerqueiral Estate
- Connection to the vine cycle and agricultural work

→ Variable conditions of the experience:

- Exterior: walk along the river and through the vineyards
- Interior: moments by the fireplace or in a more sheltered space
- Wine tasting
- Live music (informal — guitar, fado or acoustic repertoire)
- Unhurried, convivial time

 From landscape to expression — a sensory continuity



DAY 3 — PENEDA-GERÊS & SOAJO

→ Mezio


- Entry into the National Park through the Mezio Gate
- Light walk in the biological park and surrounding area
- Reading of the mountain landscape

→ Soajo

- Understanding the relationship between village, community and territory

→ End of day

- Return to the accommodation
- Dinner at leisure

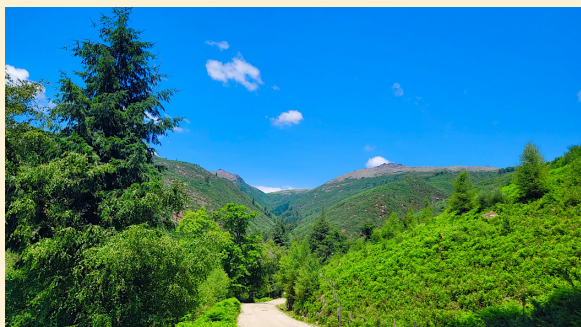
 **Guided autonomy – the territory as continuity**
